PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE 2004-05

(A Brief Report)

INTRODUCTION :-

Shivanand College, Kagwad was founded in June 1967, by a great Saint of this region – H.H. (Late) Shri Mallikarjun Mahaswamiji with the vision of providing equal opportunities of higher education to rural youth.

With the benevolent care and blessings of H.H. Shri Siddheshwar Mahaswamiji, the college is marching successfully towards materializing the vision.

The College was started with only Arts Faculty in 1967. The Commerce Faculty was added on in 1980. The College is situated in rural and border area of the state.

- b) To provide boarding and lodging facilities to students and sadhakas.
