### • Identity Not Disclosed

Students are randomly selected for the survey by system. Except particular student nobody will know which student has received the SSS email and what they have responded. Thus the students will remain anonymous throughout the process.

In SSS, twenty of the twenty one questions will be objective in nature, while one question is open ended to elicit observations and suggestions for improvements thereby providing an opportunity to the student to give suggestions and criticisms in their own words. Student Survey has 30 to 50 weightage in the scoring of institutional Grade and hence responses from students can play a critical role in determining institutional grade. 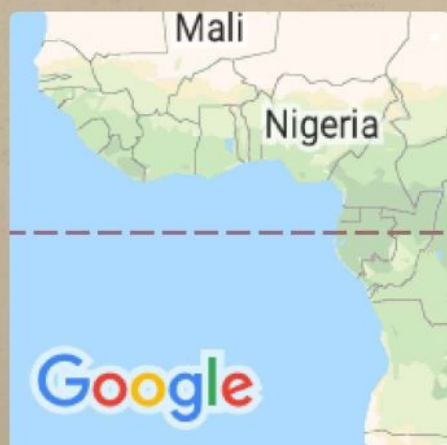

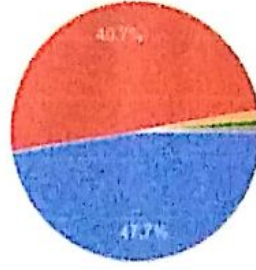

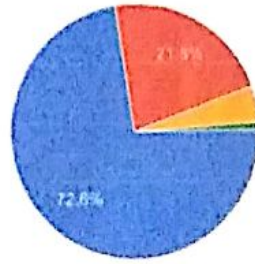

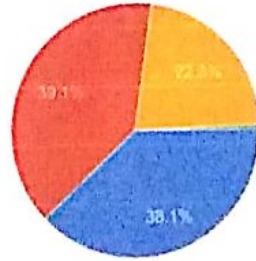
