#### **The Practice:**


Only suitable and eligible students are selected as Ideal Boy, Ideal Girl, Class Representatives and Sports Secretary to pose them as role model.

All teachers of college have instituted scholarships, cash prizes to the highest scorers in almost all subjects. The Gold Medals, Shields, Cups are also given.


### Evidence of Merit:
